Professor Peter Mathieson, President and Vice-Chancellor of The University of Hong Kong (HKU), and his senior management team have launched the strategic plan: Vision 2016-2025, which charts the University's future direction and development.

The vision is to build on HKU's internationally recognized accomplishments and become Asia's Global University. To achieve this, we will focus on the '3+1 Is strategy': Internationalization, Innovation and Interdisciplinarity, all converging on Impact. These themes will guide the three pillars of our work: teaching and learning, research, and knowledge exchange. Ultimately, impact must be the aim of everything we do; we all want our efforts to make a difference to society and humanity.

INTERNATIONALIZATION



To promote global citizenship and competitiveness, we plan to provide *all* students with at least one Mainland China and one overseas learning opportunity by 2022.

INNOVATION



Is there life out there? Are we alone? We wish to continue encouraging critical questioning and thinking to innovate for change and social good.

INTERDISCIPLINARY



By bringing together different and divergent minds, we aim to drive and catalyse new ways of thinking, new ideas and concepts, and new ways of doing things.

From contributing to finding cures for the world's greatest diseases, promoting oral hygiene in developing countries, to rebuilding homes in China, our aim is to embed impact into all of our academic and educational outcomes.

NURTURING JOURNALISM TALENTS

In 2016, the Atlantic Media Company made a gift to the HKU Journalism and Media Studies Centre to establish the Quartz Scholarship. The scholarship will support students pursuing the Master of Journalism program, which

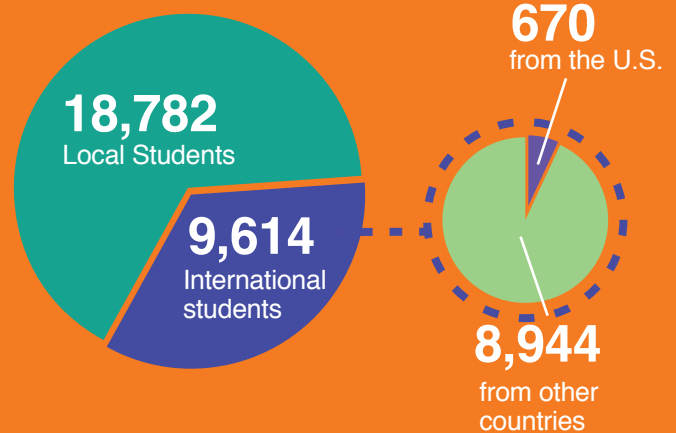

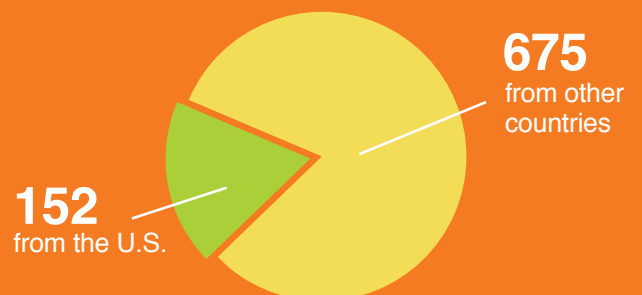
